ABOUT BREACAN

BreaCan is a unique service that provides information and support to people affected by breast cancer or a gynaecological cancer, throughout Victoria. It is a service of Women's Health Victoria, an independent women's health promotion organisation run by women for women and it is funded by the Department of Health.

Each year in Victoria, approximately 3,000 women are diagnosed with breast cancer and about 1,000 women are diagnosed with a gynaecological cancer.

BreaCan:

- Is consumer focused — that is, we are driven by the needs of people with gynaecological and breast cancer, as they define them.
- Provides quality, independent, accessible information, support and referral.
- Works together with other health and community organisations and services.
- Recognises that the experience of gynaecological and breast cancer must be seen in the broader context of people's lives.

ABOUT OUR RESOURCE CENTRE

The BreaCan resource centre is open three days a week. It is located at Ground Floor, Queen Victoria Women's Centre, 210 Lonsdale Street, Melbourne.

The centre provides information, support and referral for people affected by gynaecological cancer or a breast cancer, their carers, family and friends - we do not provide counselling or advice. Trained volunteers, all whom have experienced cancer themselves or had a close association with someone who has, staff the centre. We support people affected by gynaecological or breast cancer to:

- Talk, share their experiences and be supported by other women who have also experienced gynaecological and breast cancer.
- Access up to date, independent information about the various stages of the disease, treatments and emotional and psychological issues.
- Participate in activities such as regular information sessions on issues of interest.
- Access telephone and on-line information and referral to support services.
- Participate in exercise programs.
- Link into available support services such as counselling, practical support, local health care services, and gynaecological and breast cancer support groups.
